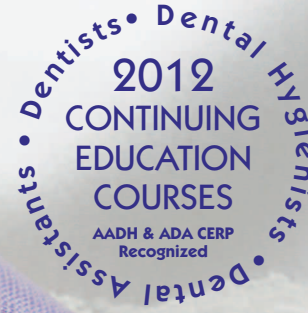

Course 1: This course is for the clinician. It will discuss the changing antibiotic options in dentistry for acute infections and prophylaxis for old and new antibiotic categories and formulations. The new 2007 American Heart Association at-risk patients and the inconsistencies for the Orthopedic Surgeons' 2009 recommendations will be compared. What should be done with the patient requiring prophylaxis already on, or recently on an antibiotic? The new approach to cardiac and vascular stents will be emphasized, based on new data and new designs. The bottom line on prophylaxis for VA vs. VP Hydrocephalus Shunts, the four approaches to dialysis, vascular repairs, IVC filters, Hickman catheters, portacaths will be reviewed.

Course 2: What must we know chair side everyday to successfully treat periodontitis in both compliant and non-compliant patients? Do the same principles apply to peri-implantitis? How do we choose between the periodontally compromised teeth, crown and bridge replacements or implants? Understand the "EVIDENCE BASED DATA" in dental literature compared to the "PROMOTIONAL DENTISTRY" of the manufacturers. Does the soft tissue program in the dental office influence this decision? Which cases are the winners and losers? What medical issues increase risk for dental failure? Learn specific protocols from curets to toothbrushes, antibiotics to analgesics, medical disease and drugs to mouthrinses and toothpaste.

CT REGULATIONS FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION

OSHA UPDATE: Federal regulations require health care workers to take an annual update on bloodborne pathogens tailored to their dental office settings.

DENTISTS: License renewal requires 25 credit hours (live or home study) biennially to include one hour of education in each of the following: 1) infectious diseases including HIV and AIDS, 2) access to care, 3) risk management, 4) care of special needs patients, 5) domestic violence, including sexual abuse is mandatory.

RDHs: License renewal requires 16 credit hours of live instruction biennially, directly applicable to patient care. CPR is a prerequisite for local anesthesia certification.

CDAs: DANB, Inc. requires 12 credit hours (live or home study) annually for membership maintenance.
